GENERAL INFORMATION: EnSpray 99® is a highly refined narrow distillation range spraying oil which contains emulsifiers to facilitate mixing with water.

DIRECTIONS FOR HOME GARDEN USE

Mixing Instructions: Pour the required amount of water into the sprayer then add EnSpray 99® and agitate well. When mixing with other pesticides add the other product first, according to the manufacturer's instructions, then add the EnSpray 99® last. Maintain continuous agitation while spraying.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE:

PLANTS	USE	RATE
Deciduous plants: Apples, pears and stone fruit	For control of European red mite, San Jose scale and aphids	15-20ml per litre of water. For scale control apply during dormant period up until green tip
Citrus	For the control of scale insects, aphids, citrus red mite and thrips	10ml per litre of water
Evergreen Plants: Roses and Ornamentals	For the control of European red mite, mealy bug, scale insects and aphids	
Grapes	Powdery mildew control	20ml per litre of water. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals.

If you have any doubt about crop safety contact Grosafe Chemicals Ltd, or apply to a small area first.

Indoor plants	Leaf polish. Apply with a soft cloth	5ml per 200ml (1 cup) of water.

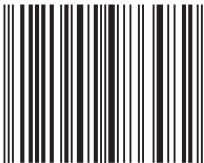

Do not spray under conditions that cause slow drying: i.e. low temperatures, high humidity. Do not spray in the late evening or early morning or during the hours of darkness: this could cause damage to the fruit.

Do not apply EnSpray 99® within 14 days of applications of sulphur or lime sulphur, once crop growth has commenced.

Consult the label of the proposed additive. If doubt remains do not mix products.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT: 821g/L (980ml/L) mineral oil in the form of an emulsifiable concentrate. Unsulphonated residue not less than 99.0%.
