

HAZARD CLASSIFICATION: Flammable Liquid, Category 4

TOXICITY: Avoid release to the environment.

FLAMMABILITY: Combustible liquid. Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames or hot surfaces. No smoking. In case of fire: use dry chemical, foam, or carbon dioxide (CO₂) for extinction.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Wearing rubber gloves is recommended when applying as product requires either ethanol, methylated spirits or alcohol based hand sanitiser to remove from skin and brush applicators. Wear eye/hand/clothing protection if there is a high chance of splashing.

STORAGE: Store in original container with lid tightly closed, and well out of reach from children. Store in a ventilated, cool place. Avoid freezing conditions as product will harden.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: If possible, dispose of by using according to the label, otherwise dispose of to an approved landfill.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse empty container and recycle empty containers through AgRecovery (www.agrecovery.co.nz).

FIRST AID: If exposed or concerned, get medical advice.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.

APPLICATION RECOMMENDATIONS:

- Avoid applying InocBloc Organic Prune 'n' Paste in damp or humid conditions.
- Always use sharp pruning tools (and sanitise tools with an approved sanitiser).
- Ensure InocBloc Organic Prune'n'Paste is only applied to clean, dry wounds.
- Brush InocBloc Organic Prune'n'Paste onto wound as soon as possible after cut is made.
- Ensure a thick, even layer is applied onto the wound surface and 1cm below edge of cut.
- Always apply on clean, healthy plant tissue.
- Clean equipment with ethanol, methylated spirits or alcohol based hand sanitiser.
- Skin can be washed down with alcohol based hand sanitiser if required.
- In cooler temperatures the product may require gentle warming for ease of use.

APPLICATION RATES:

Apply a generous, even layer to any cut, or open surfaces on vines and trees with the applicator brush cap.
