IF THIS HAPPENS Tanker/Vehicle Accident Spill or Leak		DO THIS Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Dial 111 for emergency services. Wear full protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Prevent further leakage. Collect spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
